PRESIDENT'S REPORT

On a very windy and cold September evening, our 50th season started with an Acknowledgement of Country from Quakers Hill athlete and Blacktown Council Young Citizen of the Year, Emma Hoskins. Emma encouraged us to remember the ones that walked this Sacred Land before us and to be kind to each other. We were also joined by Life Members, former KLLAC athlete and Paralympian Gordon Allan, LANSW CEO Chris Giles, representatives from other Centres in our Zone and the Member for Winston Hills, Mark Taylor.

The season began with a bang, quiet literally with a wonderful fireworks display that set the stage for the excitement of the season ahead.

Our Friday night competition continued to be the cornerstone of our program, with 18 running nights during the season attended by our 332 athletes. While we didn't witness any records being shattered this season, the remarkable tally of 3,139 personal bests broken underscored the dedication and progress of our athletes. It was encouraging to see the number of athletes who took up the opportunity to train on a Wednesday night with our coaches Annika, Tyson, Mel, Doug and myself.

A very sincere thank you to everyone who made our Friday nights possible – from the crew who spent Wednesday evenings mowing and line marking, our coaches, those who came to help setup on Friday nights, our canteen and bbq helpers, our reliable track crew and Age Managers. Your dedication and generosity with your time has helped contribute to our fantastic 50th season for our athletes.

Sadly, in October we lost someone who had made a tremendous contribution to KLLAC over many, many years. Eric Emme passed away after a short illness. Eric was a Life Member, former committee member and President, Age Manager, Coach and Official and was involved in moving KLLAC from Lalor Park to Kings Langley. Throughout the season we displayed a banner thanking Eric as a sign of gratitude and respect. We thank Eric for all that he did for KLLAC and in his name we have created a trophy to be presented to a coach or official each year.

Eric was also a Life Member of the North West Met Zone. This season we had 45 athletes compete at the North West Met Zone Championships, with 15 athletes competing at Region, with Claire, Michael and Neema qualifying for the State Championships.

To celebrate our 50th season we wanted to run a gala day, but with a little difference. We ran three Sunday afternoon events focusing on the disciplines of throws, jumps and track. We had 236 athletes compete over the three events

from 34 Centres, with 49 athletes coming to more than just one session. At each event we had junior officials manage an event. Thanks to Claire Giffney, Tory Emme, Emma Hoskins and Matilda Olson (Quakers Hill) for their contribution, and to all our officials on the days. The feedback that we received was that everyone enjoyed the quick format of the sessions and I would encourage next year's committee to look to make this a regular fixture.

I would like to thank everyone who has been involved in the Committee over my four years as President, in particular our Registrar, Helen who has served in the role for the maximum of 4 years. I thank you all for supporting me in my role and entrusting me with our 50th Season activities. KLLAC is run entirely by hard working volunteers. This season we have had tremendous support which has made running KLLAC so much easier. I would encourage everyone to get involved and volunteer some time helping with the myriad of tasks that need to be done.

I am grateful for our sponsors. Daniel Hales from Artisan has been a great supporter of KLLAC for 8 years whilst Doug Jack has demonstrated his support for KLLAC, sponsoring with his business Ideal Stairlifts, as has Nathan from First Class Mobile Massage. Our overall profit for the year is \$8,340.97 compared to a \$20,468.89 last year which is a decrease of 59 %. This is partly due to an increase of spending on canteen equipment including a new fridge and slushie machine totalling \$5,485.00. Our overall profit still remains in strong position thanks to an increase in registrations and excellent weather. We also introduced Sunday Special Sessions that were successful in increasing additional income.

Our income from registrations remains strong, up 9.6 percent for this year despite Active Kids vouchers dropping off. Total registrations were up from last year (331 vs 305).

Our uniform sales increased due to higher registrations to \$5,950.84 an increase of 40% over the previous year. Our uniform expenses increased this year although we should have plenty of stock on hand. All returning athletes also received a fiftieth anniversary shirt.

Our Sponsorship income for the year was up on an already impressive year previously to \$13,000.00. I would like to thank all our sponsors for their support over the 2023-24 season - Gold sponsors Ideal Stairlifts, Artisan, Manor Real Estate and Wastewater and Environmental Health Consultants; Silver sponsor First Class Mobile Massageand Bronze sponsors JAW Trophies and Sports and Bec's Fruit and Veg boxes.

A few other items complete our income figures for the year leading to a total income of **\$62,102.12**. Against this, our total Cost of Sales was **\$12,432.74** made up of Canteen, BBQ and Uniform stock purchases. ^Canteen sales and canteen BBQ sales were not broken up this season due to time commitments.

Our total expenditure for the season was **\$41.328.41** of which the major items are field maintenance and uniform supply that this year was entered in expenses instead of cost of sales*. This included the purchase of a new fridge and slushie machine.

The funds in the Term deposit, **\$11,095.21** are still available if we need them as these has not been earmarked for use at this time.

Kings Langley LAC remains in a strong financial position thanks to our sponsors, volunteers and healthy registration numbers. Thank you all for making our 50th season one of our best and I look forward to seeing you all next season. For anyone wishing to volunteer please see a committee member.

Registration fees

In the 2022-23 season, Little Athletics NSW (LANSW) increased the fee they charge per athlete. We therefore increased our fee to enable our Centre to remain viable.

In the 2023-24 season, LANSW made the decision:


- not to increase the fee per athlete, and
- to decrease the fee for each Tiny Tot registration by \$20, in recognition of the lower cost to the Association of these athletes as they do not go to the Zone, Region or State Championships, and are also not eligible for support through the NSW Government Active Kids Vouchers.

Kings Langley Little Athletics Centre therefore determined that for the 2023-24 season, registration fees:

- remain the same as for the previous season (\$150) for U6-U17 registrations
- reduce by \$20 to \$90 for Tiny Tots registrations.

The table below is a comparison between registration fees charged over the past 3 seasons across our Region. This shows that our fees remain competitive with those charged across our region.
